



Success story of Jengapada Village

district. Ninety-five percent of the villagers are tribal and dependent on agriculture and wage labour. 112 families live in this village. Before SEWA intervention the village inaccessible of minimum and basic amenities.

Under the Agricultural Production Cluster project the organization SEWA organized all women SHG in to a producer group called Om with focused livestock. Sairam on



Out of 112 households 40 households on goat rearing. 4 households constructed model poultry shed. 62 nos. proposals on poultry shed has been approved in Gram Sabha under MGNREGA. Besides this, in Rabi season 39 households cultivated mustered in 28.5 acare,

engapada is a tribal populated remote Potato 23 households in 9.5 acare. During this village in Kolabira block of Jharsuguda year 7 vermin compost unit has been constructed under MGNREGA. Out of 112 households 8000 birds vaccinated and 452 goats dewarming with the support of Veterinary deptt.



The households income has been increased from 25000- 30000 per annum.

In 2015 the organization intervened with WASH poilting programme under Integrated Livelihoods Support programme supported by BRLF. In collaboration with GRAMVIKAS 112 individual household toilet and bathroom has been constructed with water supply to each every households. Now the village is free from open defecation.

A success story of Padmabati Majhi

The village Sanyasipali is a tribal populated village in Kolabira Gram Panchayat of Kolabira from the department. She successfully problock in Jharsuguda District. In 2019 under APC project a producers group was formed namely Basundhara . Mrs Padmabati Mahji wife of Mr Pradip Majhi one of the key member of this group. Before a member of the group she was a house wife and her husband cultivated vegetable crop in a small patch of land. But after intervene of SEWA under APC project, Building capacity of the member on crop diversification, Package of Practice and marketing. Mrs Padmabati Majhi came forwarded take initiative to scale up their vegetable cultivation and during last financial year she had interested on flowery culture.



The field staff of SEWA linkage her with Horticulture department for Marigold flower culti-

vation in 0.25Acre. with support of 6000/duce more then 3 gntl. and sold it in local market with a price of 4000/- per gntl and earn 12000/- within a period of 3 month.



Now she happy and success models for other to scale up marigold cultivation. Now she not only successful farmer but also a good resource person to trained others in the field of flowery culture. Also she is now interested for Honey bee cultivation and determined to establish her as a successful entrepreneur.

Case study of Gulapi Naik

Jeevika Samridhii Project is a Livelihood initiative of Vedanta Limited which is been partner by SEWA organization, Jharsuguda. This project was started in a vision of supporting small and marginal farmers and increase their income. This project is been working in 3 village areas of Kolabira block of Jharsugda district viz. Siriapali, Gudigaon and Kelendamal. After the implementation of this project many farmers came forward to be a part of it. Their enthusiasm and activeness gave this project a boost to go forward in a positive direction.



Smt. Gulapi Naik is a resident of Kelendamal village and she live with her family her husband, a son and two daughters. She is 44 years old and is a very proactive farmer. She help her husband in cultivation and give her maximum time in field. She was supported with Tomato seed for 20 dc area. From this area she harvested 7 quintal 60 kg from which she got an income of Rs. 3800. She is a progressive farmer of Maa Laxmi Farmer producer group and this group was provided with a Power Sprayer and also individually she has been supported with NPM kits (Pheromone Trap and Crop Guard). Through the project she has also received organic farming training and she is interested to go for organic farming in near future. On that season she was unable to harvest sufficient quantity due to unwanted climatic condition.

In the kharif season of 20-21 financial year she was also supported with Ginger seeds of 13.2 kg for 2.2 dc area. For cultivating ginger she also received crop plan and management training where she learned about proper package of practice and proper implementation of fertilizers and pesticides in field area. She was also supported with fertilizers, pesticides and Handikhata which was also supported by Vedanta ltd to encourage the farmers in the way of proper cultivation. As she received such support she proved by through the harvesting that she had used all things in proper way. In the month of January 2021 she harvested 1 quintal 5 kg of ginger which was the maximum harvesting quantity in her group. She sold it all in Jharsuguda market for Rs. 60 per kg where she got an income of Rs 6300. It was great part in her livelihood sector where she first time cultivated ginger and got a valuable production. As well as in the Rabi season the financial year 2020-21, she got supported with Okra seeds for 0.10 Acres of land. From this area she harvested 1.5 quintals from which she got an income of Rs.3000.00.

She was also imparted with crop plan and management training for different crops which encouraged him to practice seed treatment and to follow the package of practice.

She is really thankful to Vedanta Ltd and SEWA for giving her an opportunity to be member of the producer group through which she was able to avail the support and benefit. She is happy that her income has been doubled after receiving the capacity building training and technical support guidance from the agriculture experts.

Case Study of Naresh Patel

Jeevika Samridhii Project is a Livelihood initiative of Vedanta Limited Jharsuguda which is been partner by SEWA Kumuradihi, Jharsuguda. This project was started in a vision of supporting small and marginal farmers and increases their income. This project is been working in 3 village areas of Kolabira block of Jharsugda district viz. Sirirapali, Gudigaon and Kelendamal. After the implementation of this project many farmers came forward to be a part of it. Their enthusiasm and activeness gave this project a boost to go forward in a positive direction.



Mr. Naresh Patel is a resident of Nirgundihi, Gudigaon Village which is an operational area of Jeevika Samridhhi Project. He is an Agri- Entrepreneur of Jay Jagannath Farmer Producer Group. He stays with his family with his Mother, Father or other 4 brothers. He is a progressive farmer but in last year he was stuck all kind of vegetable as well as Paddy Cultivation also but with their traditional cultivating method. He cultivated vegetables but it was in less amount only to feed his family. He was not interested in vegetable cultivation because he didn't had any idea on package of practice and market study. But after the project was introduced in Gudigaon he came forward to be a part of it. He expressed his interest to be the member of farmer group and gave his time in all activity

related to project. From Project he was benefited farm asserts like: - NPM kit (Crop gourd and Pheromone trap), Trallies System, Power Sprayer etc. and also input support received like:- Chilli Seeds, Ginger Seeds, Coriander Seeds as well as received knowledge on POP and organic farming. He has been provided chilli seed for 20 Dc area where the production came out of 3 quintal 20 kg, Ginger seed for 2 Dc area where the production came out of 60kg, Coriander seed for 10 Dc area where the production came out of 6 quintal which he have sold in Jharsuguda market with better price.



In the kharif season of financial year 2020-21 he got support of Ginger seed for the 2.2 decimal of land and from this land he got 95 kg of product and sold at market with a better price and Income is Rs. 3800.00. Then in the Rabi season he supported with the inputs of Coriander seed for the 10 decimal of land and from this area he got products in 3.2 quintals as well as sold at market with the better price and got Rs.6400.00. As well as supported the Trellis system for cultivating the creeper vegetable through the Horticulture dept and get much more benefits from the same areas of land and now he is going to cultivating the creeper crop with only trellis system and now he is 0.75 Acres of land used for the trellis with his own initiative.
